

## Holt Senior High School Annual Education Report

January 2024

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Holt Senior High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2022-23. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2022-23. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as a Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) building.

At Holt High School, our math proficiency levels have emerged as areas of focus according to our SAT, MSTEP, and local data. According to our data, we need to specifically focus on our Special Education and African American students in this content area. As a school we are focusing on Equity in our curriculum, Cuturally Responsive Teaching, and Restorative Practice. We have aligned our whole group professional development to focus on examining restorative practices throughout the school as well as high yield instructional strategies that support our consistently underperforming student populations. During Department PD time, we are focused on aligning our curriculum with common expectations and activities that allow students to show mastery. Each department is using an Understanding by Design framework to align curriculum and classroom expectations for all students. A move towards Learning Progressions will allow us to further identify areas that students struggle with and provide them feedback on areas of focus.

Our Department time Professional Development will focus on aligning our curriculum with common expectations for students of what proficiency looks like for each standard. Because of our TSI designation we have also created a team to develop and implement programs to support students taking state assessments. There are both structural changes in the schedule as well as instructional changes to support students beign better prepared for the state assessments. Lesson has been developed to help focus on key concepts students struggled with and in testing strategies.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

All students are assigned to schools based on a physical address within neighborhoods. Holt Public Schools (HPS) follow State and County guidelines for accepting and assigning in-district and out-of-district school of choice students.

Our district as well as every school in our district has an active Improvement Plan with goals extending three years into the future.

Holt Public School's Curriculum is driven by the State of Michigan curriculum standards and the National Common Core Curriculum. Access to our curriculum may be found on the district website, following the curriculum link. Additionally, curriculum maps are available in each building and widely distributed at school open houses.

We hope you take a few minutes to review this Annual Education Report and see what is happening at Holt Senior High School. Thank you to our entire school community for your continued support.
