

School Annual Education Report (AER) Elliott Elementary School

January 2025

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Elliott Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Principal Andrew Wise for assistance.

For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school HAS NOT been given one of these labels.

At Elliott Elementary, our gap between our Top and Bottom 30% has emerged as an area of focus according to our data. We are working to provide more opportunities for children to acquire the skills they are lacking in these areas. A variety of intervention groups are established to target the lagging skills. During the school day, intervention classes are provided for those students that qualify and all children receive excellent core instruction. After school, we support students with a need of acquiring standards in math with additional programming. Our core comprehensive programs for both language arts (Reading Street, Core 95, & Wit & Wisdom) and math (Go Math!) are accessed daily by teachers and delivered to our students. For those children that have been identified as needing interventions, Elliott is working with its resources and scheduling to meet the needs of all students. Conscious Discipline continues to be a building focus that supports staff interactions with students throughout the school day.

We have worked diligently to focus on the needs of the "whole" child at Elliott. Social-emotional learning has been in full effect with programming such as Conscious Discipline, weekly Social-Emotional Learning modules, daily morning meetings across the board, and restorative practices programming implemented by our staff. Our Conscious Discipline understanding and capacity has grown annually at Elliott and guides our daily decisions and interactions as educators. As a district, we have directed professional development efforts towards Culturally Responsive practices within our buildings and classrooms. We have also moved aggressively to teach our students how to become better problem solvers on their own. We continue to stress school wide strategies such as personalized greetings at the door, standardized morning meetings, calm corners, and recorded morning announcements. Elliott staff is continually researching and bringing back new ideas to our team to help our staff grow and improve programming for our students.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

All students are assigned to schools based on a physical address within neighborhoods. Holt Public Schools (HPS) follow State and County guidelines for accepting and assigning in-district and out-of-district school of choice students.

Our district as well as every school in our district has an active Improvement Plan with goals extending three years into the future.

Holt Public School's Curriculum is driven by the State of Michigan curriculum standards and the National Common Core Curriculum. Access to our curriculum may be found on the district website, following the curriculum link. Additionally, curriculum maps are available in each building and widely distributed at school open houses.

We hope you take a few minutes to review this Annual Education Report and see what is happening at Elliott Elementary School. Thank you to our entire school community for your continued support.
